Each training is individualized based on the client’s needs and follows an established curriculum which covers safety, radio communication, on-water handling, anchoring, close quarter handling and docking. Trainings are conducted on the client’s boat ensuring the client knows how to navigate the dock and waters they use every day. BOW also emphasizes the need for all boat owners to train their families and significant others, so all are prepared in the event of an emergency.

Another service area of BOW is sea trials, which consist of an overview of the boat, its functions and operations and an on-water trial run. BOW provides a delivery service to clients which can range from local deliveries to remote location deliveries.

BOW also provides “Captain for a Day” services for those clients who would prefer to have an experienced captain operate their boat so they can entertain fish or enjoy the ride.

The team currently consists of 10 Captains who have a minimum of a 50-ton Masters license and are located in New Jersey, Pennsylvania and Florida. Each captain is matched to the client’s type of boat, location and capabilities.
